The County Superintendent of Schools may, with the approval of the County Board of Education, provide for the publication and sale of materials that are necessary in connection with curricular and other services that the County Superintendent of Schools is authorized to perform.

The County Superintendent of Schools may, with approval of the County Board of Education, fix the price not to exceed the estimated total cost of production for the sale of any publication produced by him/her.

All moneys from the sale of publications shall be deposited to the credit of the fund against which the cost of printing the publication was charged.

The County Superintendent of Schools may use, sell, give away or exchange the published materials with any person, political subdivision, public officer or agency, or educational institution for educational use.
