The County Board of Education and the county superintendent of schools are constitutional officers which have duties and responsibilities specified in various codes and regulations. The County Board of Education and the county superintendent of schools are required to file the form Registry of Public Agencies with the Secretary of State.

In addition, the Personnel Commission, the San Diego County Schools Risk Management Joint Powers Authority, and the San Diego County Schools Fringe Benefits Consortium shall also file the Registry of Public Agencies.

The county superintendent of schools or his/her designee shall ensure that a revised form is transmitted to the Secretary of State within 10 days of any change in the information required to be filed for the County Board of Education, the county superintendent of schools, the Personnel Commission, the San Diego County Schools Risk Management Joint Powers Authority, and the San Diego County Schools Fringe Benefits Consortium.
