The County Board of Education (County Board) consists of five members elected from and by the voters of their districts.

The educational districts are as follows:

First District: Central San Diego

Second District: South County

Third District: East County

Fourth District: North Inland

Fifth District: North Coastal

The County Board may, by resolution, change the boundaries of educational districts. However, a change of boundaries may not be made between February 1 and December 1 of an even-numbered year and may not affect the term of office of an incumbent member.

The five educational districts shall be as nearly equal in population as possible. Following each decennial census, the County Board shall consider the population distribution among educational districts based on figures released by the U.S. Census Bureau. Educational districts shall be adjusted, if necessary, based on requirements of State and Federal law.

A change of boundaries of educational districts shall not take effect until a certified copy of the County Board resolution adjusting the boundaries has been filed with and approved by the County Board of Supervisors.
