The County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools support and acknowledge the right of a parent/guardian to direct the upbringing of his/her child. The County Board of Education and the County Superintendent of Schools also recognize that parents/guardians should have the:

- ! Right to know whether any child of theirs will be asked to disclose or reveal through the taking of any examination, survey, or questionnaire certain matters of a personal nature about themselves or their parents/guardians.
- ! Choice whether or not the student will be allowed to participate in any such examination, survey, questionnaire, practice, sample, or official test without the prior written consent of the parent/guardian.

This policy shall not be construed to interfere with or affect in any manner whatsoever the requirement of the County Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee to report child abuse.

The County Superintendent of Schools shall develop an administrative regulation to implement this policy.
