The County Board of Education recognizes that the cable broadcasting facilities at the San Diego County Office of Education are an important electronic media resource in the San Diego area. The County Board of Education supports the efficient and effective use of the Instructional Television (ITV) station operated by the County Superintendent of Schools in accordance with the Mission and Goals of the San Diego County Office of Education.

The County Board of Education adopts the Educational Access Rules and Regulations for Cable Television Franchise License Holders which insure that local cable subscribers are exposed to fair, well-balanced, informative educational, and community-interest programming which avoids the appearance or effect of promoting partisanship on political issues.

Given the statutory allocation of authority between a county superintendent and a county board of education, the County Superintendent of Schools is responsible for the programming content in San Diego County Office produced and acquired programs, and in particular is responsible for ensuring that constitutional and other legal standards are met regarding the content of those programs except as this may be in conflict with the statutory responsibilities of the San Diego County Board of Education as enumerated by Education Code §§ 1040, 1041, 1042, and other controlling authority.
