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SUBJECT: Individualized Education Program

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The County Board of Education and County Superintendent of Schools desire to provide educational alternatives that afford students with disabilities full educational opportunities. Students with disabilities shall receive a free appropriate public education and be placed in the least restrictive environment that meets their needs to the extent provided by law.

An individualized education program (IEP) shall be developed and implemented to address the educational needs of each student identified as a student with a disability. The County Superintendent shall maintain an administrative regulation regarding the appointment of the IEP team, the contents of the IEP, and the development, review and revision of the IEP.
